Bidding describes two features of your hand to your partner：Strength \＆Shape．

Every bid you make should tell your partner something about your hand they don＇t already know and something that is useful for them to know．When you hold a strong hand，it becomes very important for partner to know your shape．Shapely hands are those that are two－suited ．．．5－6，6－4，6－5 and 6－6 are unusual and need to be expressed to partner and even some three－suited hands should be fully described IF your hand is strong．

## PAGE 1.

1. D - always show hearts, but rebid spades later to show extras
2. F - this shows a fragment - playing $3 N T$ is still in the picture
3. B - must show your points - play checkback to find out if there is a spade fit
4. A - this hand shows spades without extras
5. E - shows extras - can bid 2 NT with less
6. $\quad \mathrm{C}$ - over $2 *$ by responder, the $2 \uparrow$ rebid by opener is not a reverse

## PAGE 2

1. D - find your 4-3 major suit fit, which will be better than 1NT more often
2. $\quad \mathrm{C}$ - this is an invitational sequence
3. $\quad \mathrm{C}$ - just transfer to your 5-card suit
4. $E$ - this sequence is game forcing
5. A - this is a delayed Texas transfer
6. $\quad \mathrm{F}$ - this is Smolen
