



### **False Cards**

You are declaring a spade contract and this is your trump suit:

Dummy ♠AKJ5 Declarer ♠9742

The correct play is to cash the ♠A and then finesse the ♠J on the second round. You will make 4 tricks when the ♠Q is onside with a normal 3-2 break.

However, when you cash the ♠A you see the ♠10 drop from your right hand opponent (RHO). This gets you to thinking. Does RHO have the ♠Q10 doubleton? Hmmm?

You think that a 3-2 break is more likely than a 4-1 break. You decide to play the  $\bigstar$ K and see if the  $\bigstar$ Q drops. Sadly, from your point of view, the  $\bigstar$ Q doesn't show up and your RHO drops the  $\bigstar$ 8. Even more sadly, the actual layout of the trump suit is:



What is going on? Why did RHO drop the ♠10 on the first trick?

The answer is that you have just been taken to the cleaners by a false card. Your RHO opponent inferred that his partner might have the  $\triangle Q$  so to help you go wrong they played the  $\triangle 10$  on your  $\triangle A$ .

Should you have hooked it? If you assume that your opponents will play their lowest card, the odds slightly favor dropping the  $\triangleleft$ Q doubleton (3.4% for  $\triangleleft$ Q10 doubleton, 2.8% for stiff  $\triangleleft$ 10).

What you must decide is whether your RHO might be trying to trick you or if the  $\spadesuit 10$  was a true card.

False cards or devious card play is a fascinating aspect of bridge. The next example comes from Mark Lair of Canyon, Texas. Mark is a brilliant professional player who has experienced thousands of hands and accumulated quite an arsenal of devious card play.

#### **Example 1**

False cards can be made by both sides. In this example the bidding was 1N - 3N so you are declaring 3N in a matchpoint event.



The opening lead is the ♠Q. Your RHO wins the ♠A and returns a spade. What is your plan? You have ten top tricks: 1 spade, 2 hearts, 6 diamonds and 1 club.

There doesn't appear to be a play that would enable you to garner 11 tricks since if you try to set up the \$Q, you must lose a club and whatever spades the opponents have left.

Try this. Duck the second spade and win the ♠K at trick three. Run the diamonds and pitch the ♥7 and ♥9 as your first two cards. Finally, pitch a low club on the last diamond. You have a GREAT chance of scoring your ♥2 at trick 13.

#### **Example 2**

This tip comes from Dorothy Hayden Truscott from her book *Bid Better, Play Better*.

As declarer if you want the opponent to continue a suit, signal as if you were their partner. That is, play a high spot card if they play standard signals and a low spot if they are playing upside down.



LHO opens the ♠K against your notrump contract. You can see that it will be to your advantage if LHO continues spades. If your opponents are playing standard signals, your RHO will play the ♠3 and you will play the ♠6. LHO sees that the ♠2 is missing and may continue spades playing his partner for the ♠A32.

If the players are using upside down carding your RHO will play the  $\clubsuit 5$  on the first trick and you must play the  $\spadesuit 2$ . LHO sees that the  $\spadesuit 3$  and  $\spadesuit 6$  are missing and may play his partner for the  $\spadesuit A65$ .

Conversely, if you want the opponents to shift, play a low spot card if they play standard signal and a high spot card if they play upside down.

Against your spade contract LHO leads the ♠A and RHO plays the ♠4 (standard signals, hoping for a ruff). Your best chance of enticing LHO to shift is to play the ♠2. This may cause LHO to place the ♠J94 in RHO's hand and shift before setting up the dummy's ♠Q.

If they are playing upside down RHO will play the ♠3 on the first trick and you should play the ♠9. This may fool LHO into thinking that RHO holds the ♠432 and again shift before setting up the dummy's ♠Q.

#### Summary

False cards or devious card play is a fascinating aspect of bridge. False cards can be made by both the defensive and offensive sides.

One needs to have thought ahead about the potential false card and to have known the opponents carding style ahead of time. False cards should be played at a smooth, even tempo. If you hesitate, the probability of success will diminish. As declarer to entice the opponent to continue or shift, signal as if you were their partner.
